At the end of second grade, 69 percent of those students were no longer in the state's remedial category on the national Degree of Reading Power (DRP) test. In the one school that tested the method in second and third grades, between 64 and 76 percent of the students in different years moved out of the remedial category according to the DRP post-test. On the state story reading test the students did even better, with successes ranging from 86 to 92 percent.
